Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him. He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

DISABILITY AWARENESS SUNDAY: Today we're focusing on disability awareness during our Christian-education classes and worship service. Our goal is to share with our congregation and children that we are a church that welcomes all people with abilities and disabilities. Also, we want to educate everyone about disabilities and experience what it may feel like to have certain disabilities. Our long term goal is that our church would have resources and trained volunteers so families of children with disabilities feel comfortable bringing their children to church—and not just children but adults as well. They are all made in God's image and all have a purpose in His body, the Church. We taught these main points in our children's classes especially:

1. God created us all perfectly with similarities and differences.
2. God loves all people in spite of our differences and weaknesses; he has a purpose for each of us.
3. God teaches us to love like he loves and to be friends with people regardless of differences.
