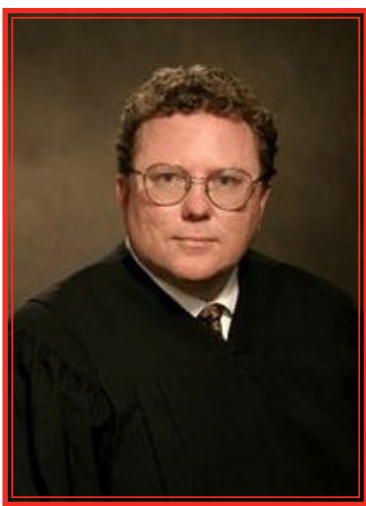


# First Wednesday Men's Lunch

Mikell R. Scarborough was born in Charleston and raised in Camden, South Carolina. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of the South in 1980 and his juris doctor degree from the University of South Carolina School of Law in 1983.

Following service as a judicial law clerk, Judge Scarborough served as Assistant Solicitor to Donnie Myers of the Eleventh Circuit solicitor's office in Lexington, SC. In 1991, he moved his law practice from Columbia to Charleston and was in solo practice from 1999-2003, when he was sworn in as Master-in-Equity for Charleston County, a special circuit court judge in South Carolina who hears civil, non-jury trial matters.

Judge Scarborough served as an assistant county attorney for Charleston County from 1998-2002 and as attorney for the Charleston County Election Commission from 1999-2003. He was a member of the Charleston County Planning Commission for 12 years and was chairman through the County's Comprehensive Planning process from 1997-2001. Prior to his appointment to the bench, he served on the Charleston County Public Defender Board and the Berkeley/Charleston/Dorchester Council of Government.

Judge Scarborough is married with three children. He is the senior warden of St. Michael's, where he and his family have been members since 1983.
