### **Within Community**

Community Groups are the main ministry of Redeemer outside of Sunday morning worship. Connect with a community group during the week for great fellowship and Bible study.

However, community groups at Redeemer Presbyterian Church in Charleston, SC, are much more than just Bible studies. These groups are like “house churches” where we want to live in community with each other like Luke writes about in Acts 2:42-47 because we’re a *family on mission together*.

**NEW CITY CATECHISM:** In 2018 our Redeemer church family will be learning and encouraging the memorization of *The New City Catechism*, which comprises only 52 questions and answers (as opposed to Heidelberg's 129 or Westminster Shorter's 107). There is, therefore, only one question and answer for each week of the year, making it simple to fit into church calendars and achievable for people with demanding schedules. Our Christian-education classes will incorporate the learning of these questions and answers into our current curriculum.
