GOD REVEALS HIS WILL FOR OUR LIVES

from **Romans 6:15-20**

What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but
under grace? By no means! Do you not know that if you
present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves
of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death,

or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms, because of your natural limitations. For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness leading to sanctification.

Within Community

GLOBAL HYMN SING: Over 4,000 churches in 70 different countries will participate in this year's Hymn Sing! We sing *Jesus Shall Reign* with more than 800,000 believers across the globe. We focus on missions because 29% of the world's population live in places where they have little or no access to a Bible, a church, or a believer. That's over two billion individuals (or 6,900 people groups) that are considered unreached and in need of someone sent from outside their community to share Jesus with them.
