Order of Worship

January 6, 2019

GOD CALLS US TO WORSHIP

from Ecclesiastes 3:1-14; Psalm 135:1-3

LEADER: For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:

PEOPLE: A time to be born, and a time to die;

LEADER: A time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted;

PEOPLE: A time to kill, and a time to heal;

LEADER: A time to break down, and a time to build up;

PEOPLE: A time to weep, and a time to laugh;

LEADER: I perceived that there is nothing better for them than to be joyful and to do good as long as they live; also that everyone should eat and drink and take pleasure in all his toil—this is God's gift to man.
